AMOUNT

Students are allowed to use the Anchorage School District Scholarship Folder Application in lieu of our application as long as ALL the information we request is filled out to our specifications. The winning entry will be retained by the scholarship committee; all other entries will be returned by June 1st.

PAYMENT

Checks will be given to the winner. Renewal checks will be issued upon receipt of an Official Transcript showing the student has maintained a 2.0 G.P.A. with a minimum of 12 credits the previous term as well as proof of enrollment in the next term with a minimum of 12 credits. Failure to maintain a 2.0 G.P.A. in the previous term will result in the ineligibility of future grants. Any scholarship winner who leaves the program (does not attend school for the normal term) is ineligible for future awards.
