- 2. Currently a student of any age, working toward your 1st degree with proof of at least 12 college level credits at a 2.0 overall grade point average.
- 3. Demonstrated need.

PAYMENT

Checks will be given to the winner. Renewal checks will be issued upon receipt of an Official Transcript showing the student has maintained a 2.0 G.P.A. with a minimum of 12 credits the previous term as well as proof of enrollment in the next term with a minimum of 12 credits. Failure to maintain a 2.0 G.P.A. the previous term will result in ineligibility of future grants. Any scholarship winner who leaves the program (does not attend school for the normal term) is ineligible for future awards.
